3 Tuition fees

In 2026, the Study Abroad tuition fees are split into Group A and Group B:

FEE Group A

Includes units from business, design and psychology, communication:

- Study Abroad fee per unit: USD \$1,050

FEE Group B

Includes units from engineering, biomedical, computing and cyber security.

Student Life at ECU Sri Lanka

Our campus location in Colombo, Sri Lanka is conveniently situated between the central business district and the Sri Lankan parliament area, providing modern facilities and amenities.

Facilities

Computing Labs

Our state-of-the-art computer labs offer students access to high-speed internet and programs to help with their courses, including the Microsoft Office suite, multimedia applications, and other specialist software that might be required. Students can use the computer labs any day of the week between 8am and 8pm, whether it's for internet research, to complete an assignment or project, or just to browse. Visitors, students and staff also have access to wireless networks on-campus. These networks provide access to the ECU website, the Student and Staff Intranets and the Internet.

Library

Support is available both locally and from WA. You will find an up-to-date collection of online textbooks related to your course as well as access to a large collection of online resources.

Furthermore there are numerous student hang out spaces located throughout the university campus to enjoy some quiet time or catch-up with friends.

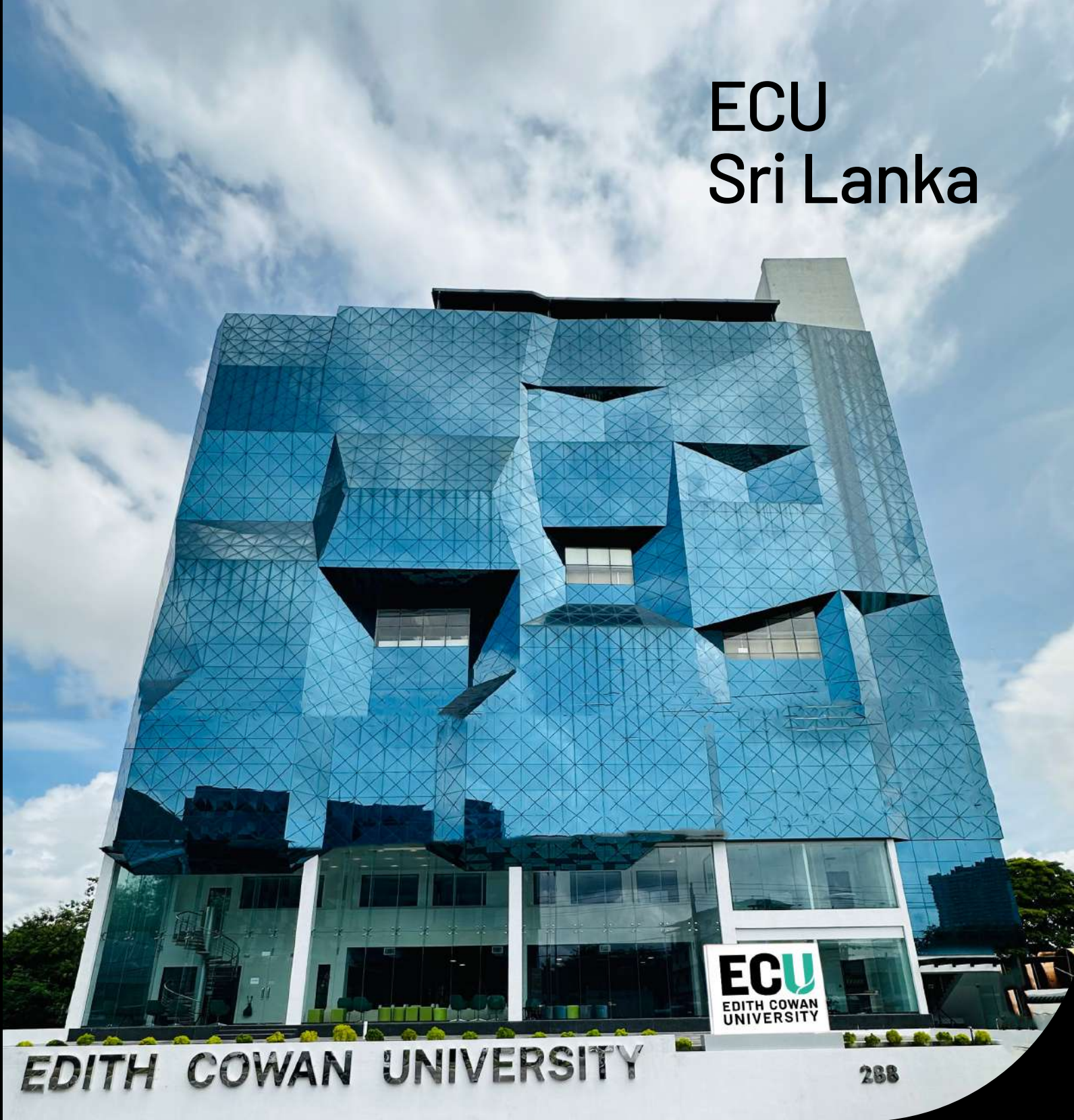

How to apply: your study abroad journey

To be eligible for Study Abroad, you will need to meet English and Academic entry requirements.

English undergraduate entry

Academic IELTS overall minimum band score of 6.0, with no individual band less than 6.0. Visit the English Competency page for equivalent tests ecu.edu.lk/how-apply/international-applicants/.

You may satisfy English if you have completed 0.375 equivalent full-time study load (EFTSL) of your university degree in English and are from Austria, Belgium, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Iceland, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden or Switzerland.

Alternatively, if your home university can provide a letter confirming that you have a CEFR level of B2 or above, this will be accepted.

Academic undergraduate entry (band 3)

Admission may be satisfied through the completion of secondary schooling, an Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) qualification or successful completion of 0.25 EFTSL of study at bachelor level or higher at an Australian higher education provider (or equivalent).

Private Property Rentals

You are usually required to sign an agreement with the rental agent to finalise rental and deposit fees. The cost could include a refundable deposit and could include an agent commission, along with the monthly rent and utility expenses.
