Berkeley Global Access (BGA)

Who: Undergraduate, graduate students and professionals

When: one or two semesters (4.5 or 9 months of study)

What:

- Study abroad for most academic majors
- Choose your own courses (space available only)
- Study alongside U.S. students
- Transfer credits to your university
- Professional development workshops
- Includes a 1 unit career course OR a 1 unit graduate school admissions course (optional)

Pace of Study:

- Full-time
- Required course load: 12–18 units per semester

Berkeley Global Access (BGA) Which Classes Are <u>Unavailable</u>?

- Graduate level courses in business, physics, cyber, data science, economics
- Undergraduate courses in business and economics that are not on the departments' lists of approved classes
- Undergraduate & graduate courses in architecture, landscape architecture, real estate, and city planning (CED Department)
- Courses that are at capacity or have a waitlist are not recommended

- 1 semester of undergraduate coursework
- Minimum GPA: 3.0
- Essay (statement of purpose)
- Proof of English Language Proficiency*:
 - Waived for Danish students
 - No English test score required

Berkeley Haas Global Access Program (BHGAP)

Who: Undergraduate and graduate students, professionals interested in entrepreneurship & innovation

When: one or two semesters (4.5 or 9 months of study)

What:

- Take classes at top-ranked Haas School of Business
- Company visits in SF Bay Area and Silicon Valley
- Career coaching and professional development
- Curriculum focuses on entrepreneurship / innovation
- Two program tracks: graduate and undergraduate
- Exposure to Silicon Valley startups and companies

Pace of Study:

Full-time; required course load: 12-15 units/semester

Berkeley Physics International Education Program (BPIE)

Who: Undergraduate students with at least one year of studies completed

When: one or two semesters (4.5 or 9 months of study)

What:

- Study rigorous Physics courses
- Unique research opportunities
- Study alongside U.S. students (Physics majors)
- Opportunity to receive a letter of recommendation from Berkeley Physics faculty
- Academic and professional development workshops faculty lunches

Pace of Study:

- Full-time
- Required course load: 12 units per semester



Tuition, Fees & Scholarships

Application Fee: \$100 (non refundable)

Scholarships:

- \$2000 scholarship for BGA
- \$5000 scholarship for BHGAP
- Apply at same time as program application



Tuition Fees (per semester)

- Berkeley Global Access Program (BGA): \$13,900 (12 units)
 - Most students take 12 units
 - Price increases if student takes more units (18 units = \$18,400)
- Berkeley Haas Global Access Program (BHGAP): \$21,900
- Berkeley Physics International Education Program (BPIE): \$23,175

Cost of Living

- \$11,250 per semester
 - Each semester is 4.5 5 months
 - \$2,250 per month
- Students must show proof of cost of living funding



- Application Fee: \$25
- Tuition: \$615 per unit charge
- Registration Fee: \$550
- Document Management Fee: \$71
- International Service Fee: \$500

Visiting International Student Requirements

- Students traveling to the United States: Obtain the appropriate student visa and enroll in courses full time.
- Online only students: No visa needed and no minimum enrollment requirements if you study from outside the U.S.
- All international students: Meet the English Proficiency Requirement
 - This requirement is waived for all Danish students
