
Course search and syllabi - The University of Auckland

Study Abroad students can take courses across different disciplines (4 courses per semester) at the University of Auckland. The University waive prerequisites in most UG courses or assess them based on their home university study.

a. The first place to look for courses is the University course catalogue. In this page, students can find by which faculty the course is offered and in which the semester(s) it is (with timetables). Also, they can view a brief outline of course. For example, the course below (PSYCH 201) is offered by the Faculty of Science (Academic Group) in Semester Two 2019 (by clicking the button 'View Course Schedule').



b. When students need detailed information on courses (syllabus), they need to visit each faculty website - the links below will take them to the page straight away. The Faculty of Arts, Business and Engineering are publishing most syllabi online, but other faculties are working on this. If students cannot find a course syllabus online, please contact the Study Abroad team at studyabroad@auckland.ac.nz. Then the team will get one for them.
