WA COVID-19 Update

27 October 2020

New cases today:

Current active cases:

Two new cases of COVID-19 have been recorded overnight. Both cases involve returned overseas travellers in hotel

New cases, last 7 days:

21/10 22/10 23/10 24/10 25/10 26/10 27/10

Regional tests completed: 81,175 480.530 Total tests completed:

All 55 active cases involve returned overseas travellers or international maritime workers.

All cases remain in quarantine.

Unknown sources2:	15	
Total confirmed cases1:	764

Cover your mouth/nose when you cough or sneeze using a tissue or flexed elbow

Avoid shaking hands or other unnecessary physical contact with others

If you are sick, stay home don't go to work or school if you have symptoms

Anyone in WA can be assessed for a COVID-19 test if they present with ANY of the following:

- a fever of 37.5°C or above OR

- a documented history of a fever in the last few days OR

an acute respiratory infection (e.g. shortness of breath, cough, sore throat) OR - acute loss of smell or taste
