Usually 8 modules totalling 120 Essex credits [60 ECTS]


Calendar Year (January - December)



Skills for Success


The Skills for Success team provides support for all Essex students, including:

English Language Requirements

- IELTS 6.0 with a minimum of 5.5. in each component
- TOEFL iBT overall score 76 with 17 in listening,
 18 in reading, 20 in speaking and 17 in writing
- We may accept other certificates

Academic Requirements

- We require students to be in good academic standing
- Students must also meet any prerequisites for the modules they would like to take
