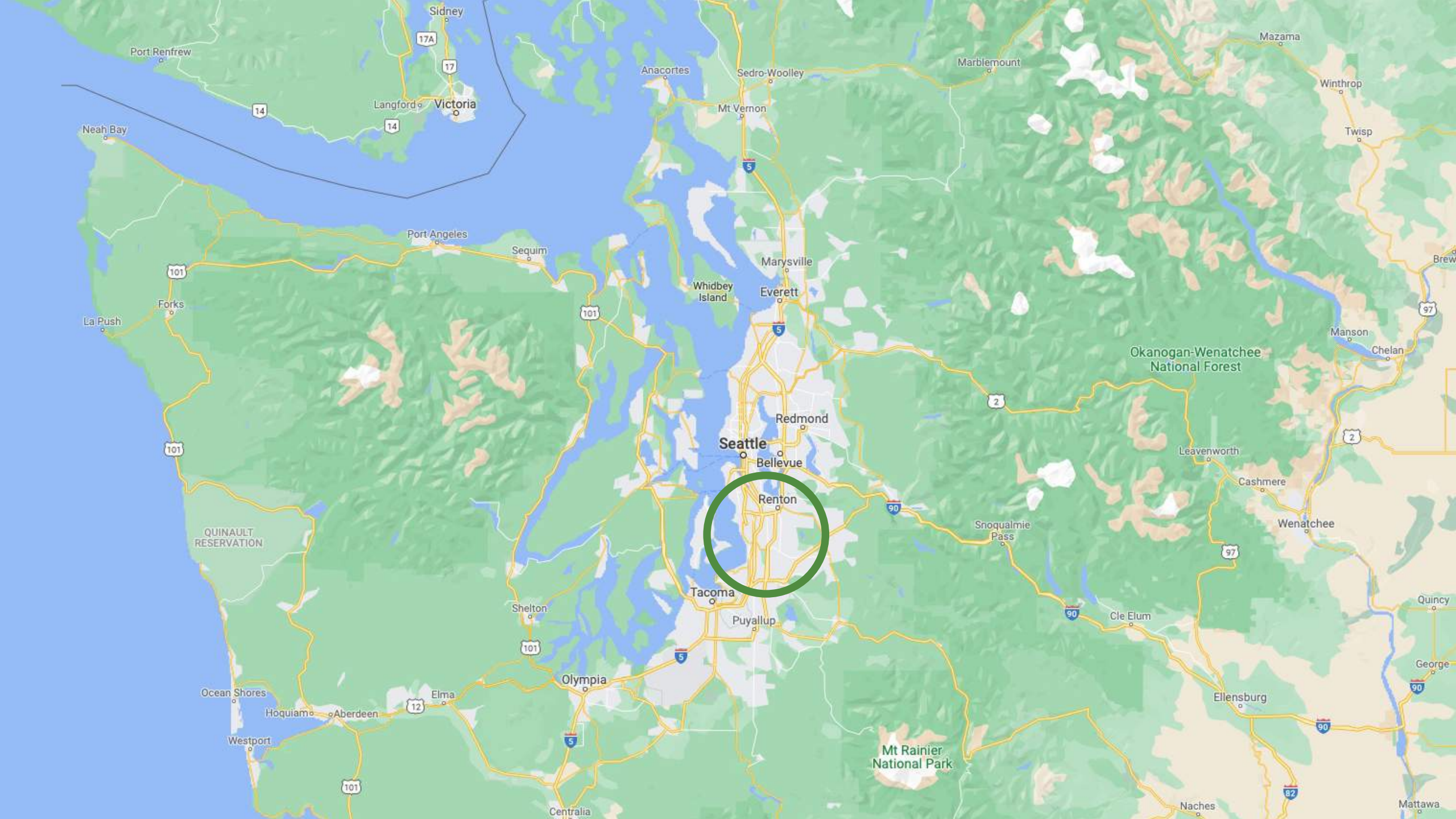


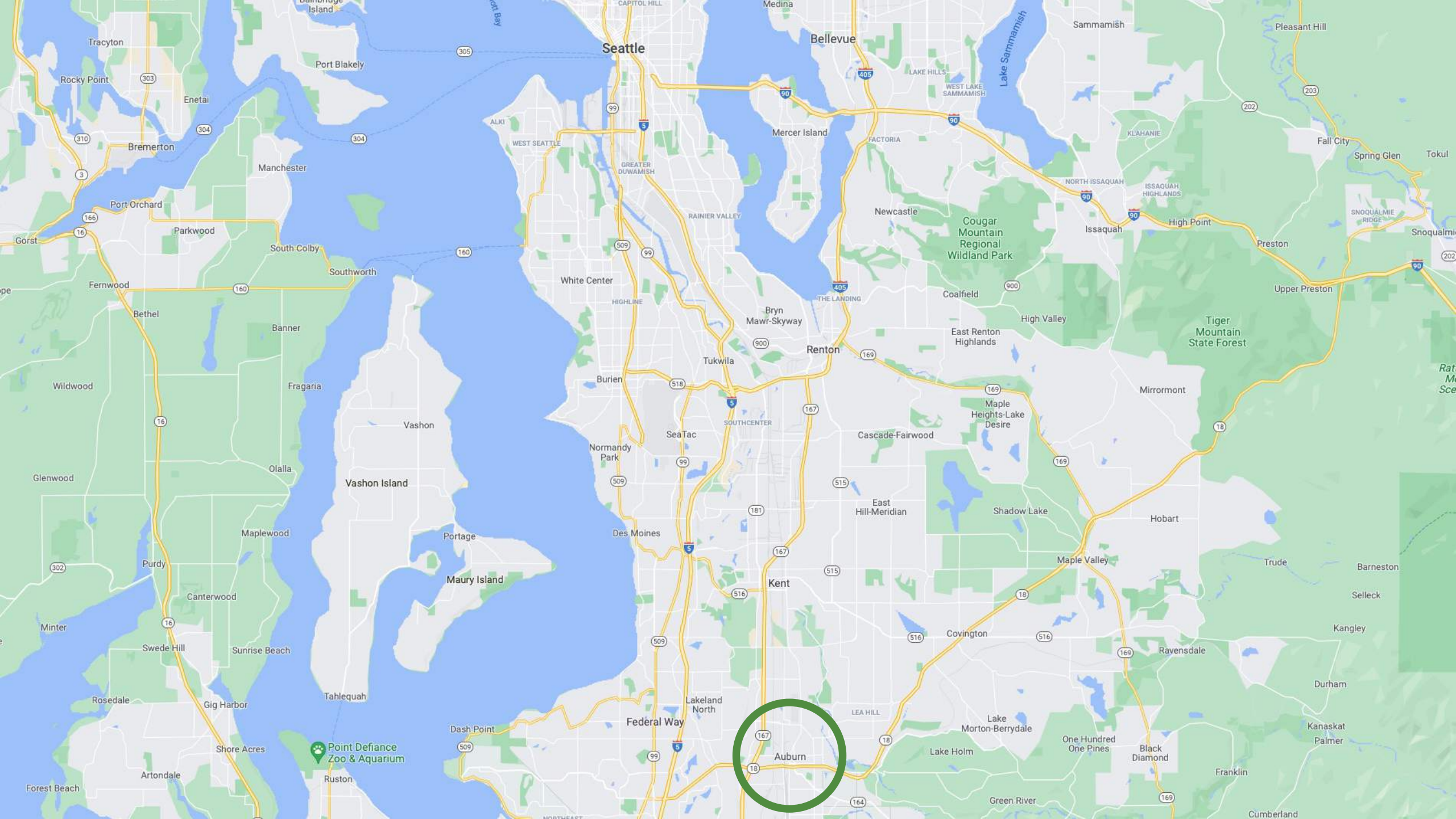
GrC – General

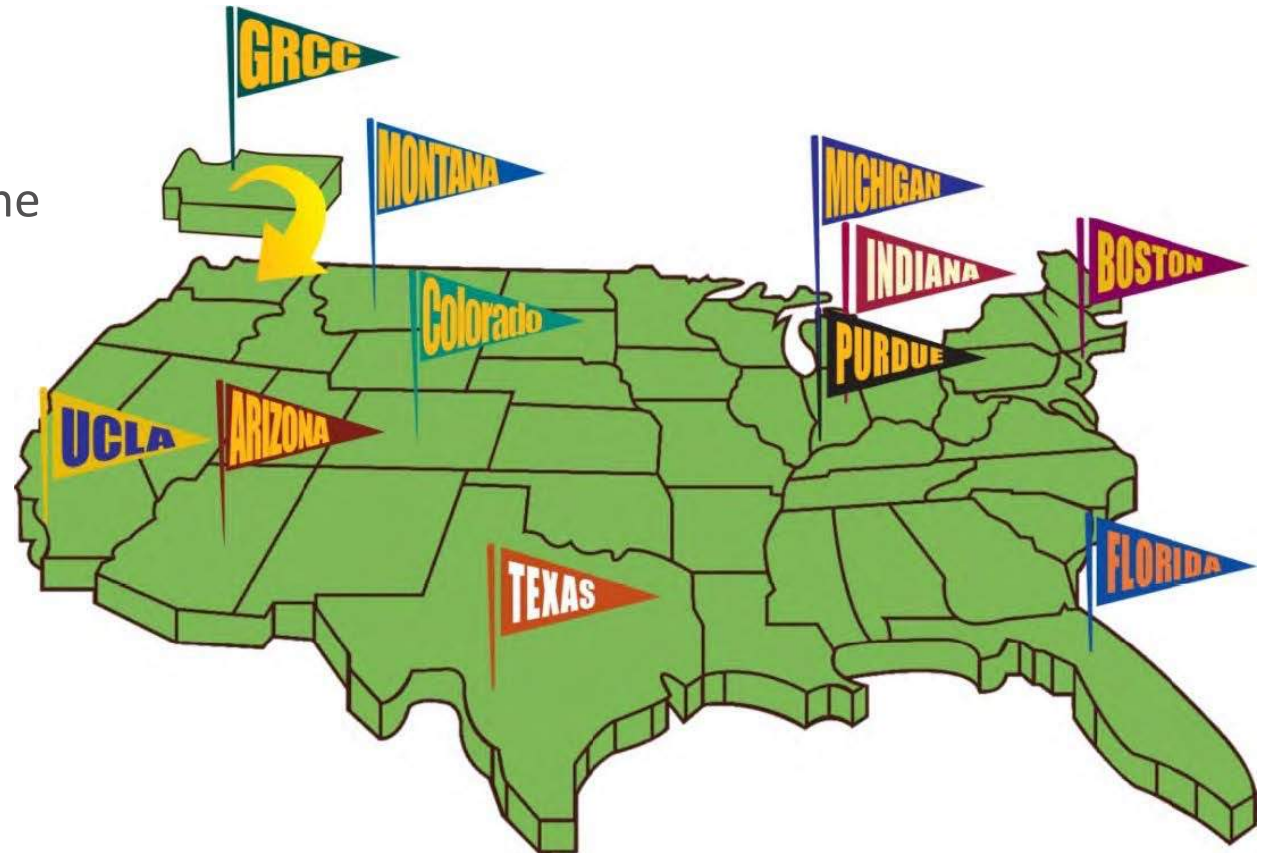

Costs

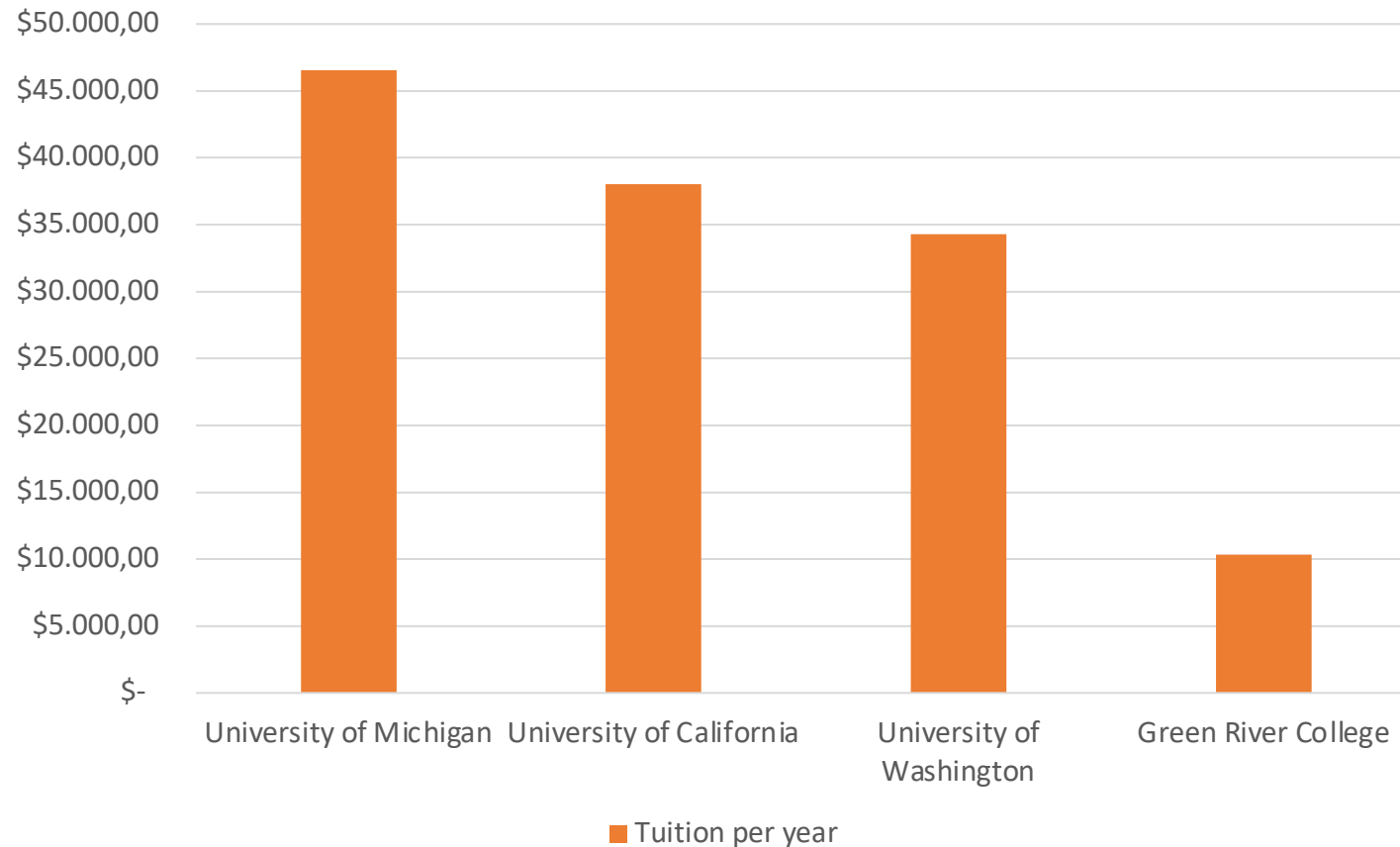


- Tuition & fees based on 12-18 credits

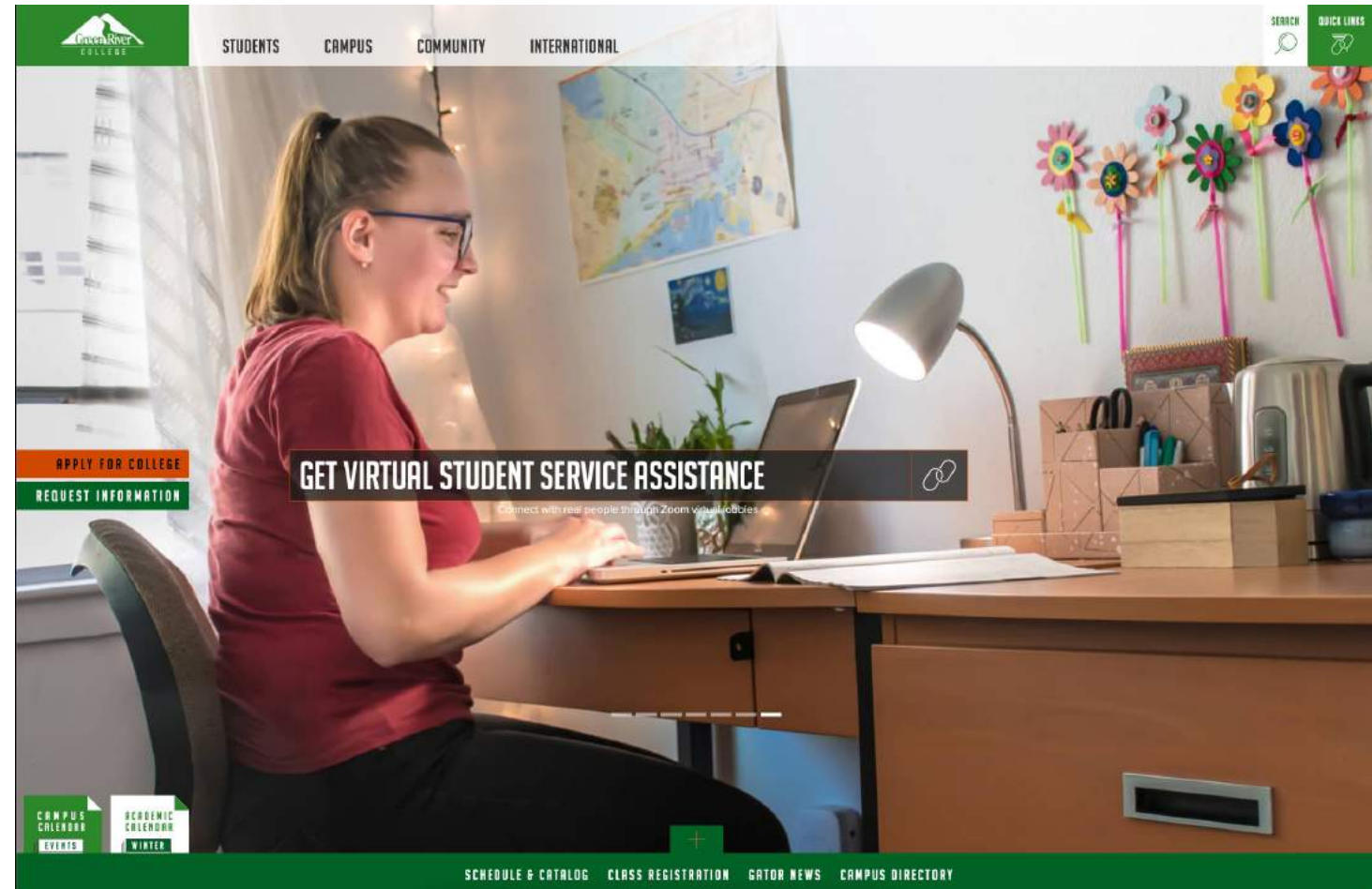
