The Australian Government requires students to have access to a minimum of **AU\$21, 041** (Australian dollars) per year to meet their living costs.

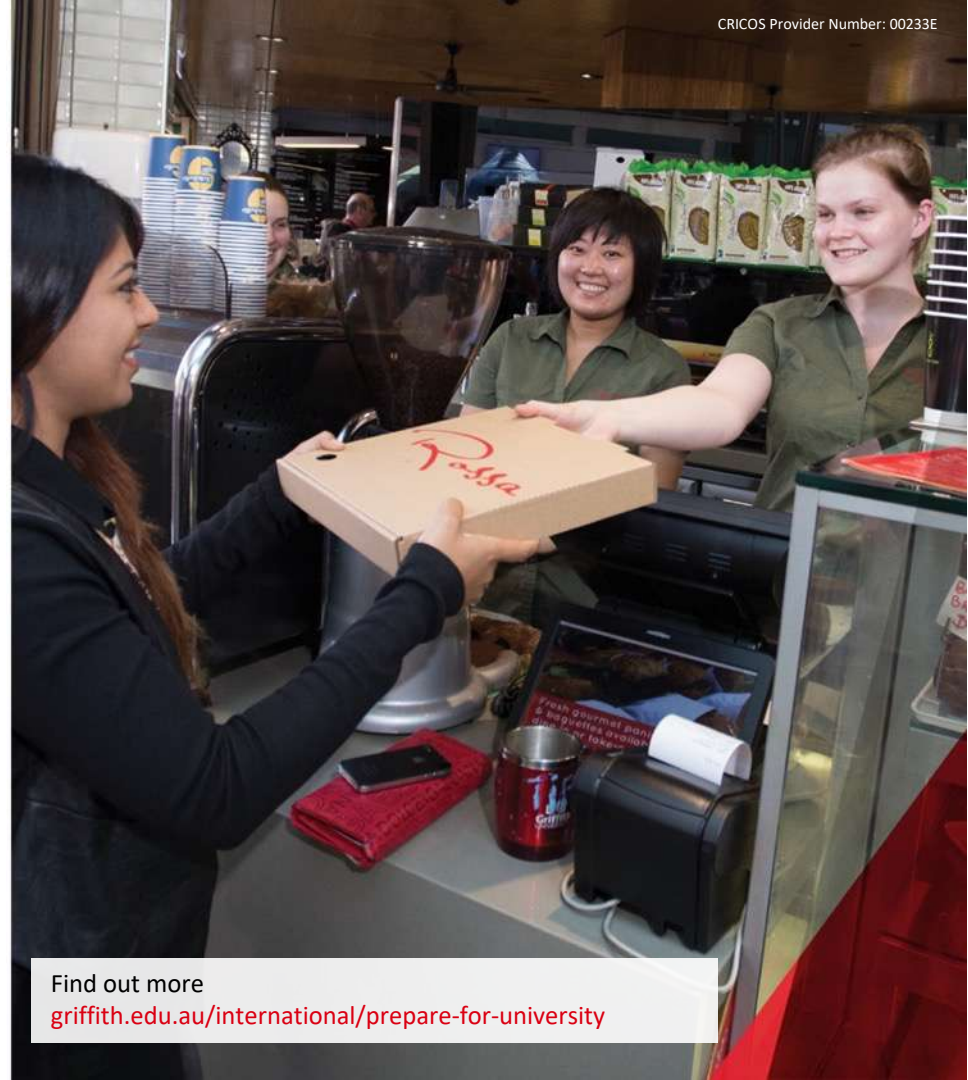

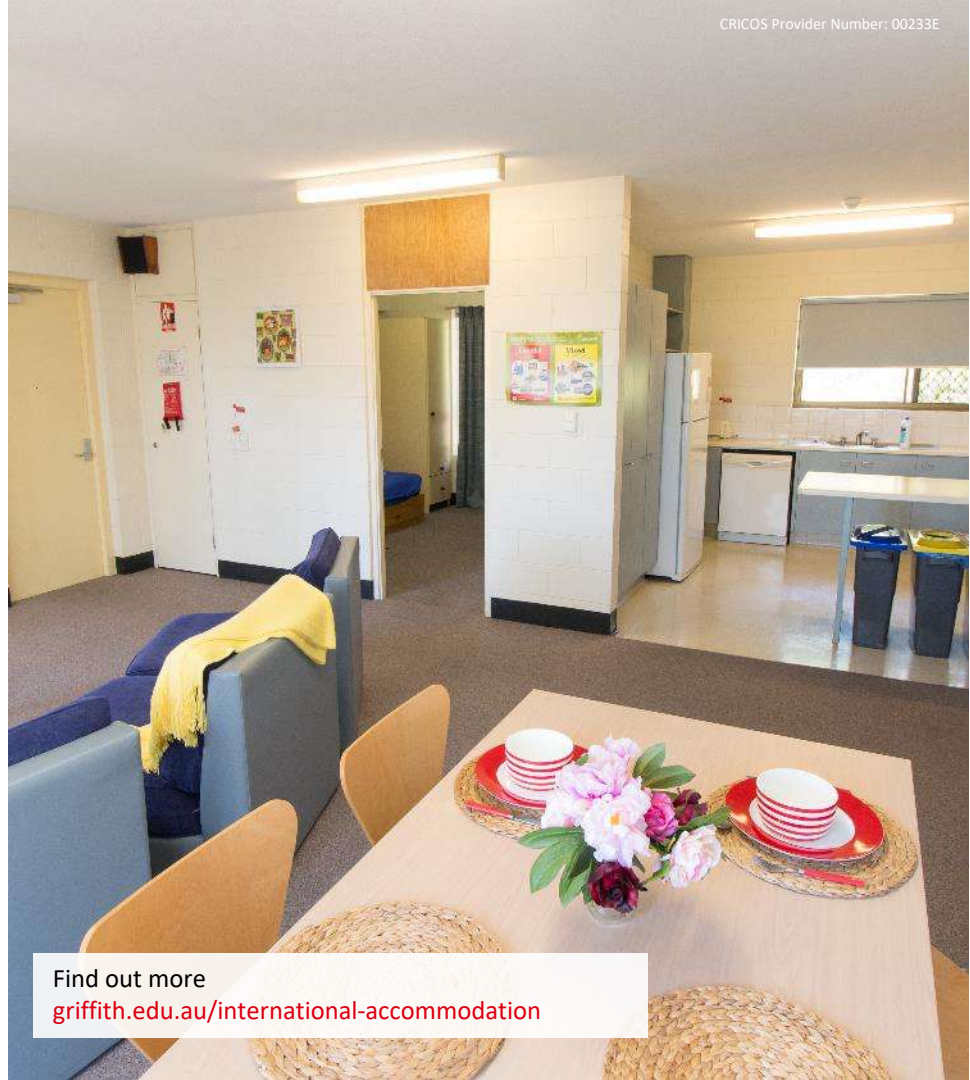
