

Estimated Fees

These requirements are not negotiable. They represent a modest average per-semester budget that does not include luxuries of any kind. We strongly recommend that you budget at least 10% more if possible. Too little money can cause distress and distract you from your primary objective – focusing on your courses. We insist that students and their families look closely at the costs of living and studying in the U.S. and make careful plans to be sure your needs will be met. Please note that these costs are *not* the costs that you will pay directly to St. John's, but a **guideline** for what you can expect to spend each year in the U.S.
