

## **Requirements for Study Abroad students coming in to RMIT Vietnam MBA**

1. In the case where a student is already enrolled in a MBA or EMBA program at their home university, we will allow them into our MBA courses without restriction, provided they meet our published MBA entry requirements.
2. In the case where a study abroad student wishes to enrol in any course for which pre-requisites are specified, they must show that they have already attained successful completion of MBA course(s) in their home university which are deemed by RMIT Vietnam MBA Director to have equivalence with the specified pre-requisite courses.
3. In the case where a study abroad student wishes to enrol in any course for which a specified number of credits should have already been attained, they must show that they have already attained an equivalent number of credits in MBA course(s) in their home university.
4. All documentary evidence to support the above must be officially certified true and correct and provided by the student, whether hard or soft copy (at the discretion of RMIT Vietnam MBA Director).
5. All Study Abroad students are subject to the rules and obligations of RMIT University Vietnam in general and the RMIT Vietnam MBA in particular, as amended from time to time.
6. Any exceptions that may be granted to any student, whether study abroad or not, for any purpose, will not be considered a precedent, nor deemed to be an amendment to any rule or obligation.
7. In the case where a student is NOT already enrolled in an MBA at their home university, but wishes to enrol in one or more MBA courses at RMIT Vietnam, the following will apply:
  - a. Such an application for enrolment will only be considered if the student is enrolled in a recognised coursework Master Degree program at their home university and has already successfully completed one-third of the course-work component of that program.
  - b. The student must be able to demonstrate an acceptable level of familiarity (i.e. at least equivalent to that of a graduate of a Bachelor of Business degree) with the vocabulary of Business Management in general as well as that of the course content in particular.
  - c. All other requirements, as listed in points 3 to 6 above, must be complied with.
8. In all matters pursuant to the above, the decision of RMIT Vietnam MBA Director will be final and not negotiable, with the proviso that no decision may be in conflict with RMIT Vietnam's stated policies or at variance with any condition imposed by the Registrar, as amended from time to time.
9. All decisions regarding Study Abroad students will be made in good faith with the aim of upholding the high reputation of RMIT and ensuring the quality of student experience in the MBA.
10. These requirements are effective 1 June 2014 and remain in effect until amended.
