- LAWS6047 Legal System of Australia

If taking LAWS1000-4000 level courses, LAWS6047 must have been taken or is being taken concurrently. (Excluding LAWS1010 and LAWS1011)

The remaining courses should be selected from courses from the Law School's list of directed courses at LAWS 6000 level. Directed courses running in semester 2 are listed below.

In principle, core courses (see the list in the [program handbook](#)) are also open to overseas law students provided that LAWS6047 is concurrently enrolled.

No approval is required from the Program Convenor or Program Advisor if students are selecting from the list below.
