
• La Trobe Accommodation office can assist students with finding on-campus and offcampus accommodation

### **New Student Accommodation Project for 2021**

- AUD\$100 million student accommodation project at Melbourne (Bundoora) campus
- Two new buildings offering additional 624 beds to students
- Total beds at Bundoora campus will be 2150
- The new buildings will comprise of single, 4, 5 and 6-bed apartments, including accessible units for disabled students
- Designed with innovative, sustainable and environmental features, with most of the existing trees being preserved in the placement and shape of the buildings
- Much of the building is pre-fabricated off-site, making the construction on campus as quick and noise-free as possible

## **Study Abroad Eligibility**

- University grades: C average or GPA 2.5 on a 4-point grading scale
- English requirements for undergraduate entry:
  - IELTS Academic (valid for 2 years from program commencement date)
    - Undergraduate, Overall score of 6.0, with 6.0 in all components
    - Postgraduate, Overall 6.5, no band less than 6.0
  - TOEFL iBT (valid for 2 years from program commencement date)
    - Overall score of 64, with 13 in Reading, 12 in Listening, 18 in Speaking and 21 in Writing
    - Overall score of 79 with 13 in Reading, 12 in Listening, 18 in Speaking and 21 in Writing
  - Studentereksamen or Hojere Forberedelseseksamen (valid for 5 years from program commencement date)

## **2021 Study Abroad Tuition Fees**


- 4-subject option (30 ECTS): AUD\$9400 per semester


