
### **Off-Campus Accommodation**

**4-subject option (60 credit points):** AUD\$9400 per semester


**3-subject option (45 credit points):** AUD\$7050 per semester



# New! - Offshore Online Bursary

It is a top-up fee reduction of up to 30% offered to students who have been disadvantaged by the Australian border closure.

- Available for La Trobe students who are located offshore and studying their Bachelor's or Master's coursework program online.
- The OOB will be available for the online subjects a student completes while located offshore.
- The bursary is automatically awarded to students who meet the criteria.


