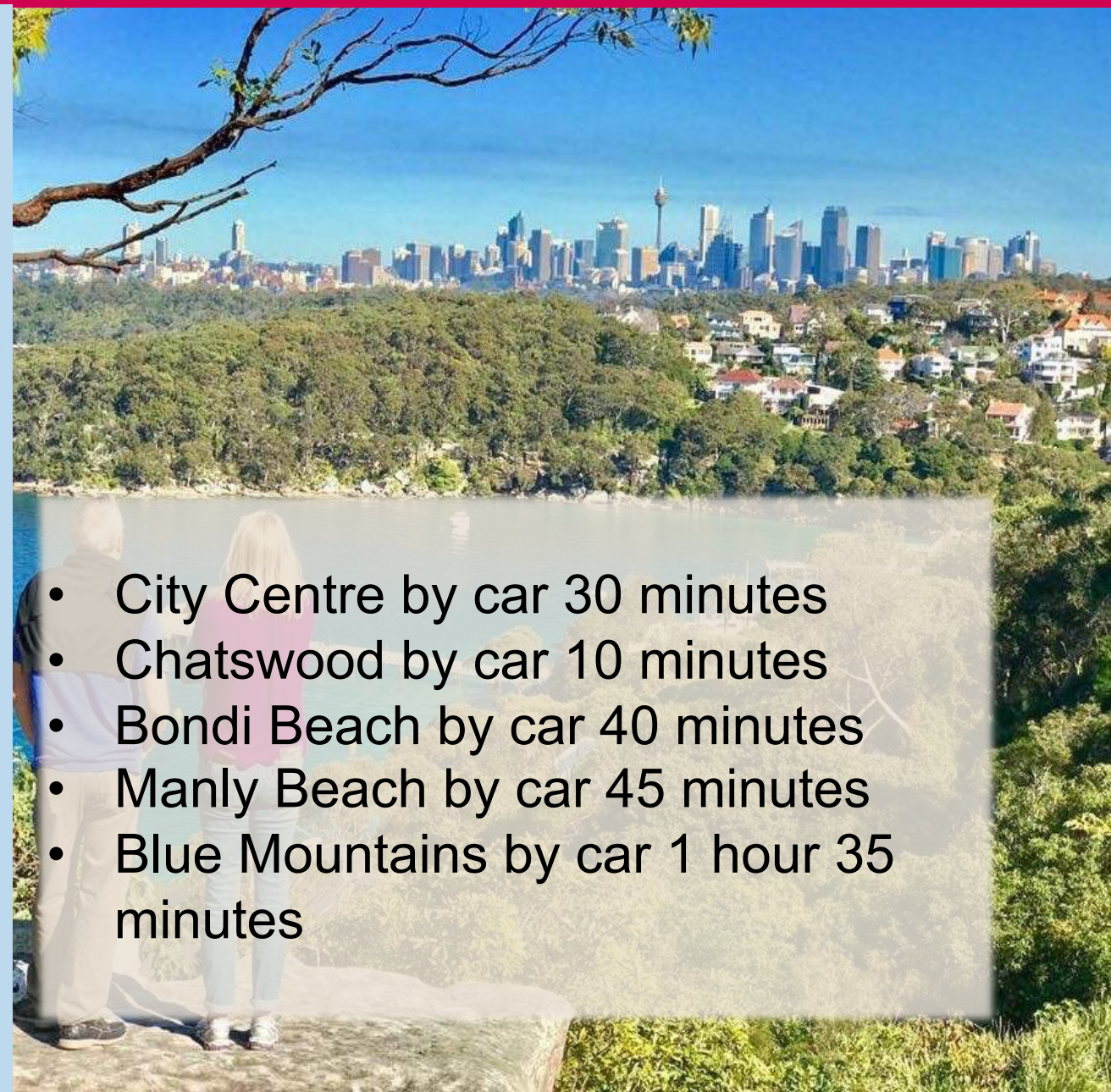

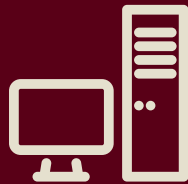

Global Leadership Program (GLP)

Leadership Skills and Global Knowledge



Customised version of the program for Study Abroad students, designed to be easily completed in one semester.

No cost, no GPA requirement, no assessments.

The GLP program entails:

- Choice of 4 colloquia from a variety of topics.

- Attendance at 'approved event', such as the Innovative Leaders series

Optional activities:

- Foreign Affairs series – two per session

- Cultural Days to Auburn and Cabramatta – small fee to cover lunch and entry fees

- Domestic Symposium (Canberra) – once per session, subsidised cost.

Upon completion: Students receive a completion certificate, transcript and reference letter at the end of their semester

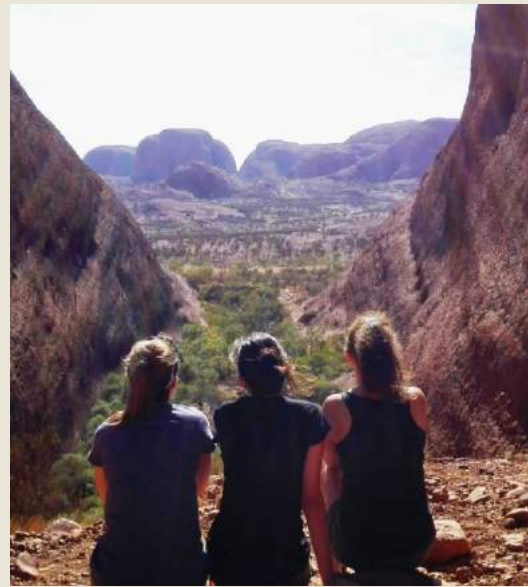
