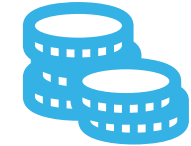

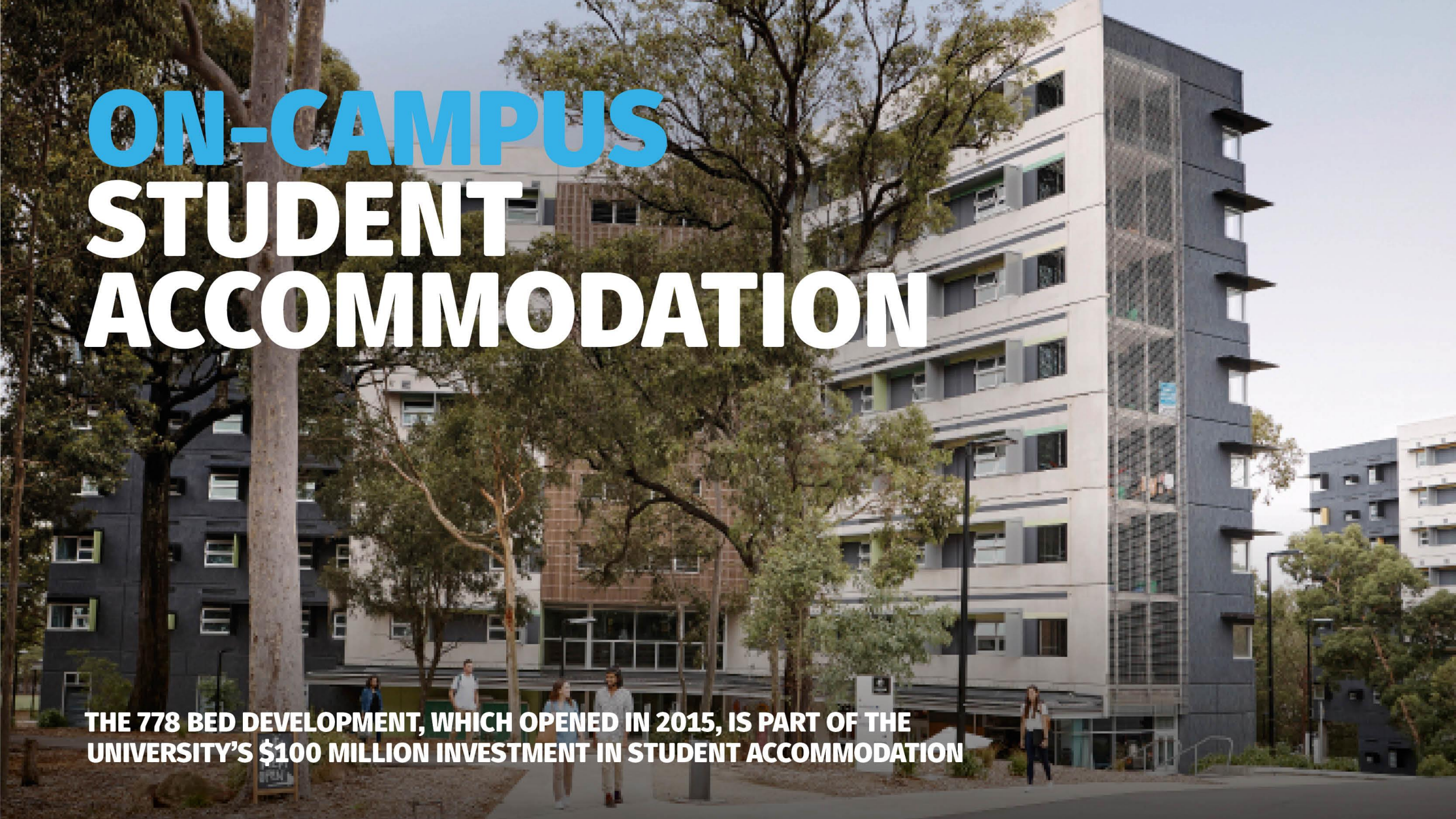

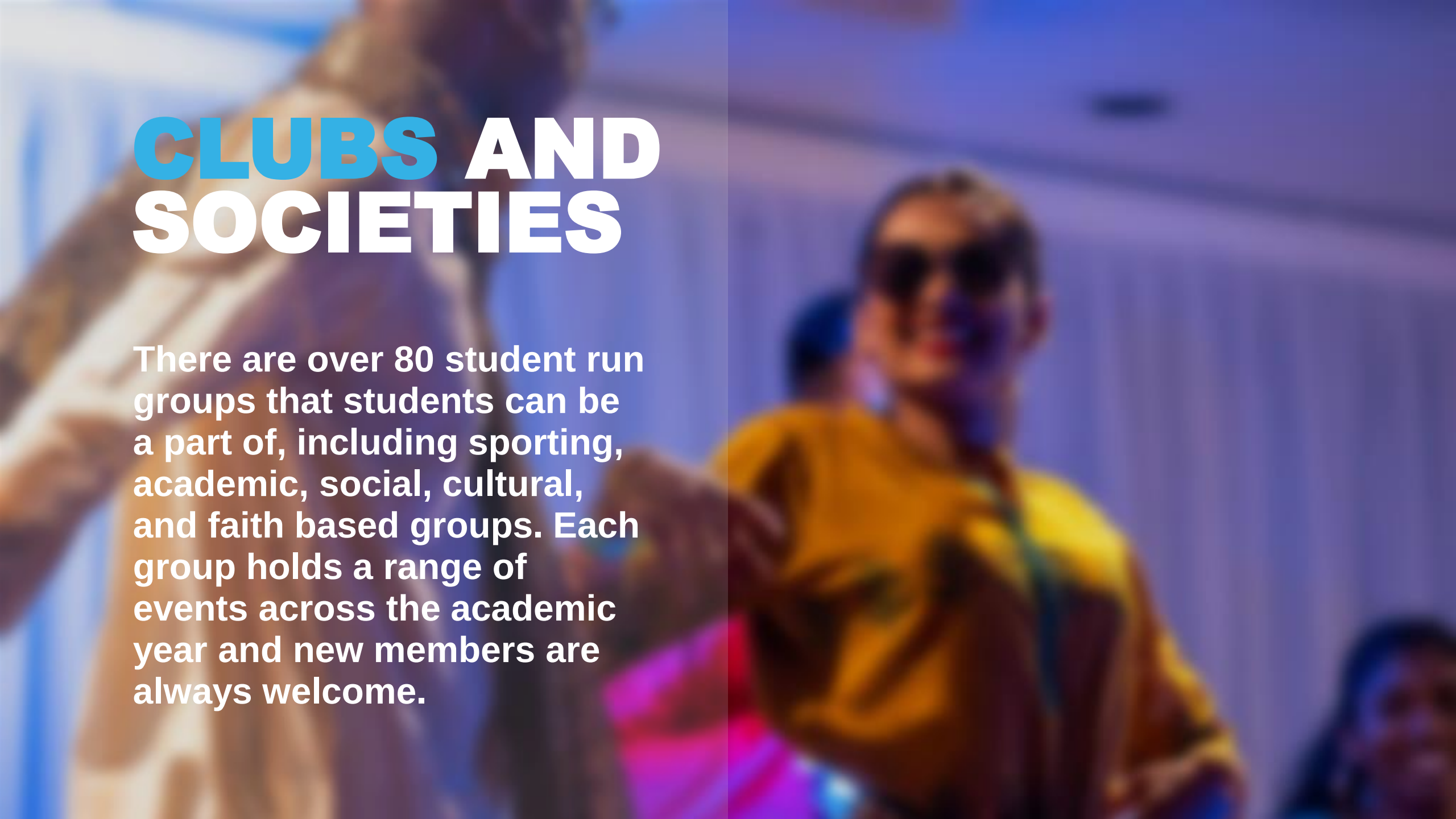
SPORTING FACILITIES

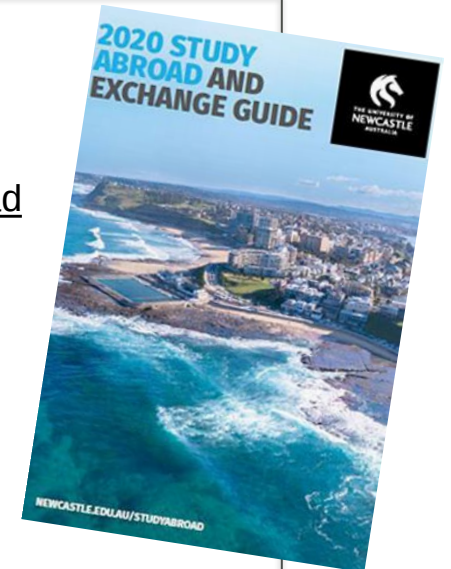
