



Important Notes:-

- Cost of Living Approximately USD700 per month/DKK4500 (inclusive accommodation)
- Modules are worth 10-20 credits each.
- -60 Nottingham credits (30 ECTS credits) in one semester
- -120 Nottingham credits (60 ECTS credits) over 2 semesters
- Modules are taught in English
- Grading is based on %
- Tuition fee is @ DKK50,000-DKK85,000 for 1 full year
- Pay ½ for 1 semester programme
- Medical Insurance



VISA APPLICATION PROESS

Documents required for residents of all countries

- Passport sized photograph with white background size (Read EMGS photo specifications)
- •Clear cover to cover scan of all passport pages. Ensure that two passport pages are in **ONE** A4 paged paper. Your passport should be valid for the duration of your course to receive a Student Pass for the duration of your course.
- •Complete academic certificates/transcripts (including English proficiency test, if applicable) in English. For academic certificates/transcripts in other languages, a certified true copy of the English translation must be submitted together with the original version.
- Unconditional offer letter from UNM.
- •Proof of payment of RM2,660 visa fees (payable thru MyNottingham portal) (RM2000 visa deposit + RM1660) visa fee
- Health Declaration Form
- Student Declaration Form
