A Study Abroad program at RMIT is an excellent opportunity for students to see the world, experience new cultures and develop as a person and an employee



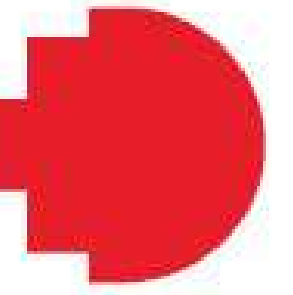


Saigon South Campus

- Impressive library with 550,000+ books, e-books, journals and e-journals



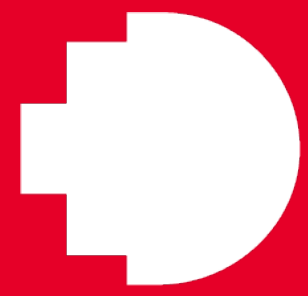

June

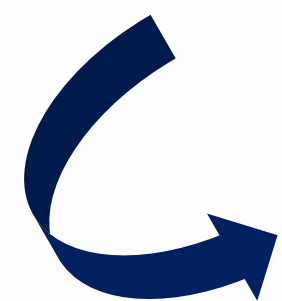

Sem 2: Jun - Sep

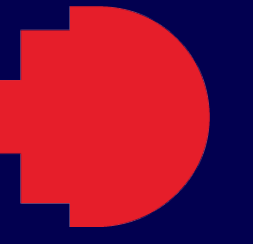

How credit works?

1 RMIT course = 12 credit points ~ 7.5 ECTs
(except for double credit course)

>>> 3 RMIT courses ~ 22.5 ECTs

>>> 4 RMIT courses ~ 30 ECTs

What's it like to study at RMIT?

No more stressful exams!

Students will have 3-4 assessment tasks during their semester; either individual/group projects; written assignments or presentations

Design your own timetable

- Study Abroad students get early access to the timetable system
- Required study load: 3 hours per course per week.

Simple Visa process

- 2 weeks for a Visa Invitation letter, 2 - 5 business days for Visa grant at the Embassy
- 4 weeks of Visa before semester starts; plus 4 weeks of Visa after semester ends

Vietnam – Heart of Asia

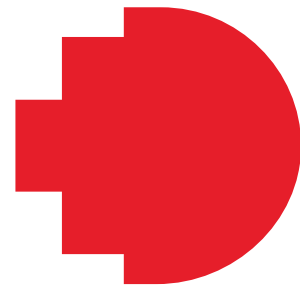


(major cities within 3 hours flight)

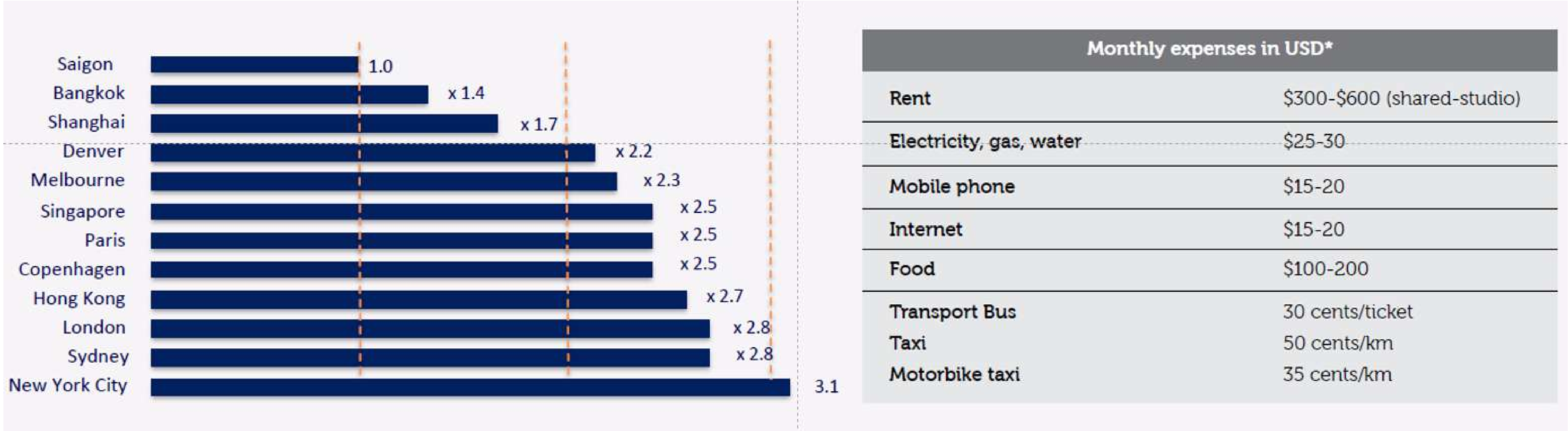


Vietnam estimated Cost of Living
