





Study Abroad - Entry Requirement

- Completed at least one full year of studies (96 credits) at home institution
- minimum GPA of 2.0 or 60% or equivalent (if you have a lower GPA, it will be assessed on a case-by-case basis)
- meet RMIT's English requirements or CEFR B2 as confirmed on an official letter from home institution
- be 18 years of age or over at time of application

Melbourne campus maps














Melbourne City campus
