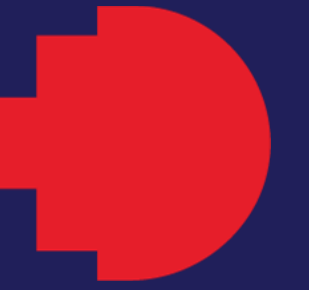
Hanoi Campus

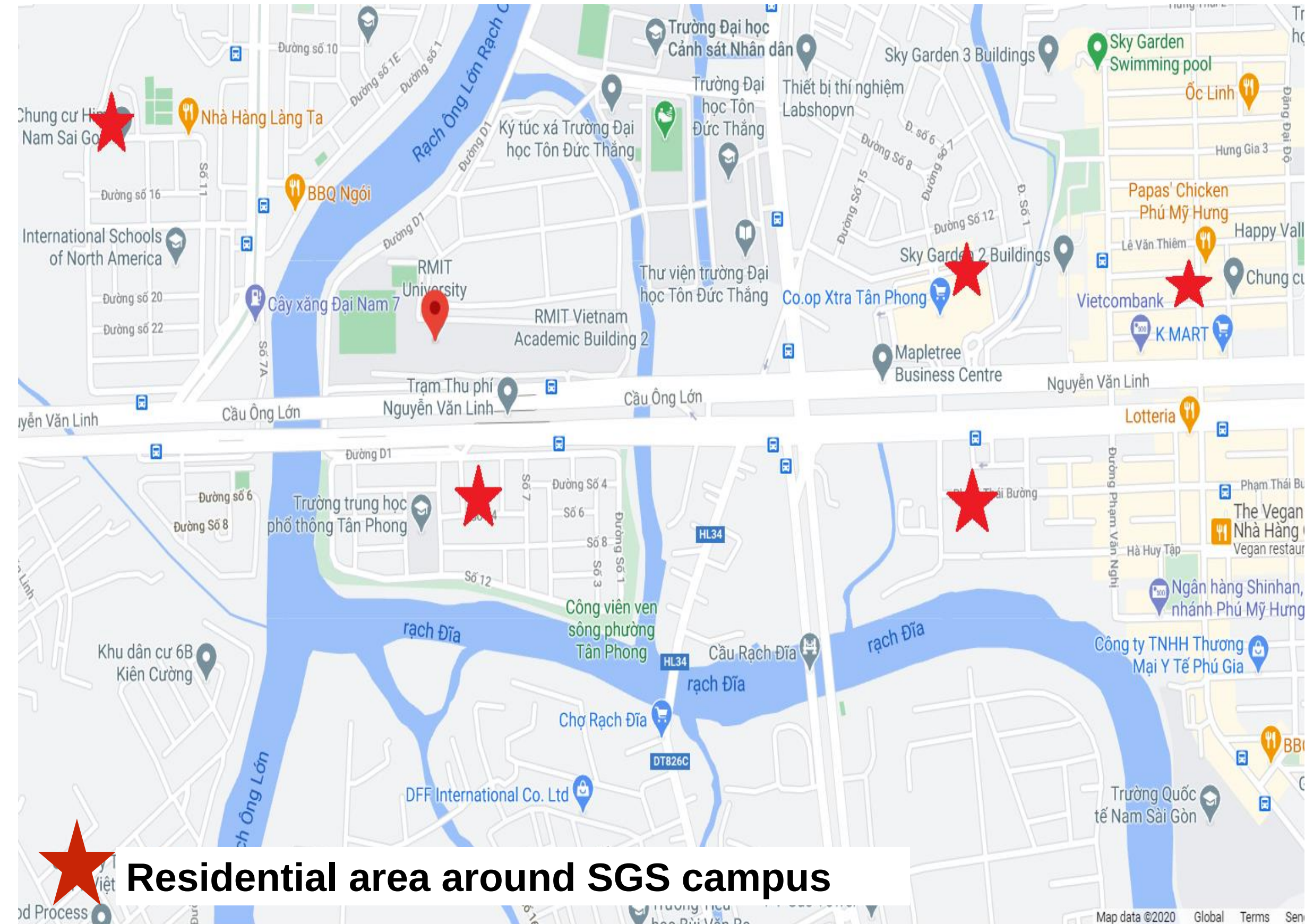

At RMIT Vietnam, there are three intakes each year:

February

June/ July*

October

** The July intake is for students who have just finished their high school graduation exam.*

Trimester system of study:

Sem 1: Feb - May

Sem 2: Jun - Sept

Sem 3: Oct - Jan



HOW TO APPLY STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM



STEP 1

CHECK THE ENTRY REQUIREMENT

STEP 2

DESIGN YOUR STUDY PLAN

- Select RMIT courses using the course search tool.
- Make sure you take into consideration the course restrictions, Higher Education calendars and campus location.
- Get approval for the course options from your home school

STEP 3

ENSURE YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS READY and THEN APPLY

Apply through online portal requires students submit all documents at once

STEP 4

RECEIVE OFFER LETTER WITH COURSE OUTCOME AND ACCEPT OFFER

Student needs to accept the offer to secure a place in the program

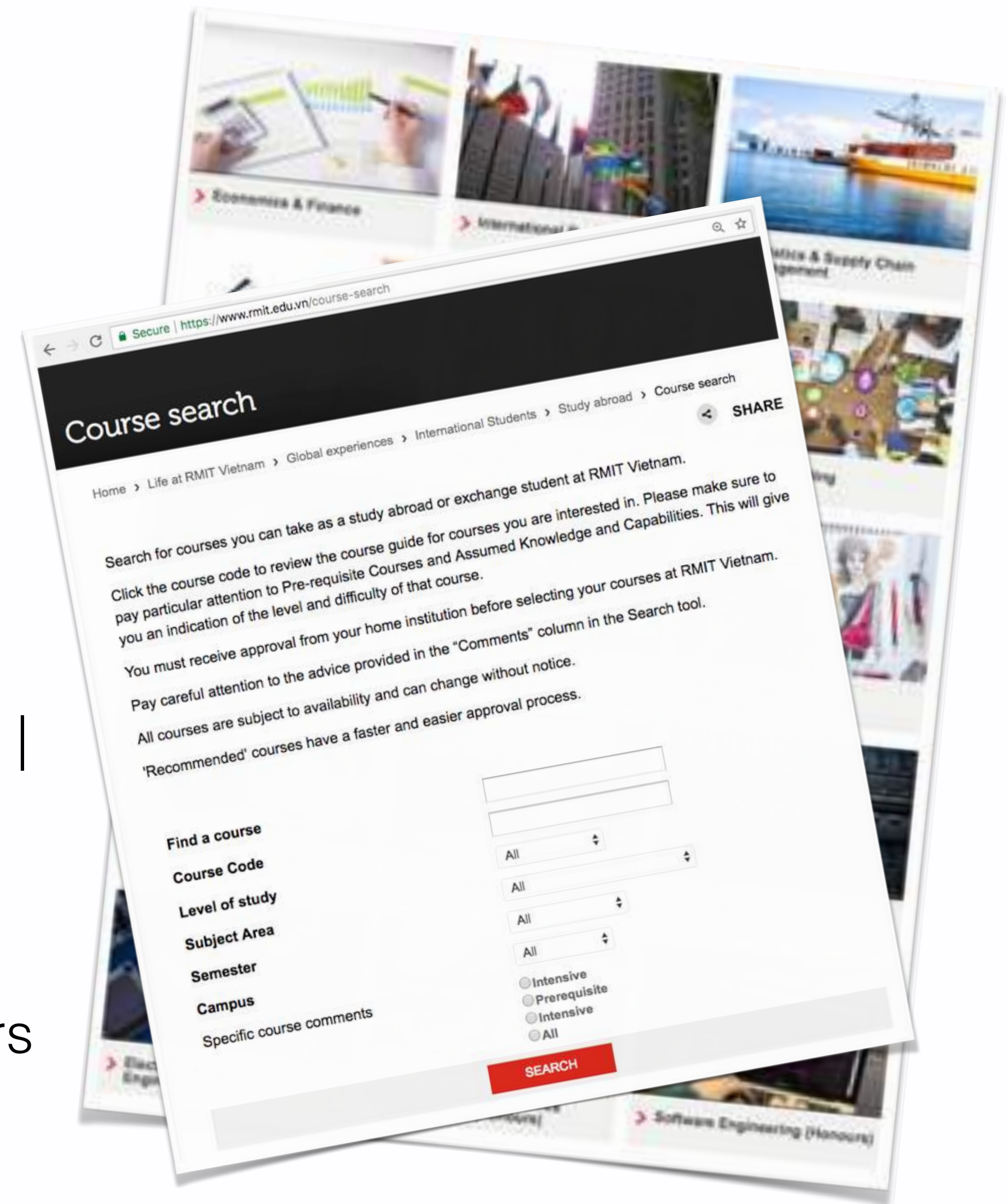
STEP 5
