- 1. Type the subject code or subject name in the search bar and select the subject to view.
- 2. Select year and instance to view the availability. All subjects must be available in the same campus and the in same semester.
- 3. Pay attention to any announcement as the subject may change in the future intake.
- 4. When you select a subject please bear in mind the subject year and requisite rules.
- Year 1 e.g. EDU1DLC: Subject in year 1 normally doesn't have requisite rules.
- Year 2 or 3 e.g. EDU2TPM: Subject in year 2 or 3 normally have prerequisite rules.
- Year 4 or 5 e.g. LAW5ICL: year 4 Honour degree or Master level subject.
- Requisite rules:
 - Corequisite: a subject must be taken at the same time as another subject.
 - Incompatible with: cannot do these two subjects at the same time.
 - Prerequisites: have to pass subject(s) before taken this subject.
