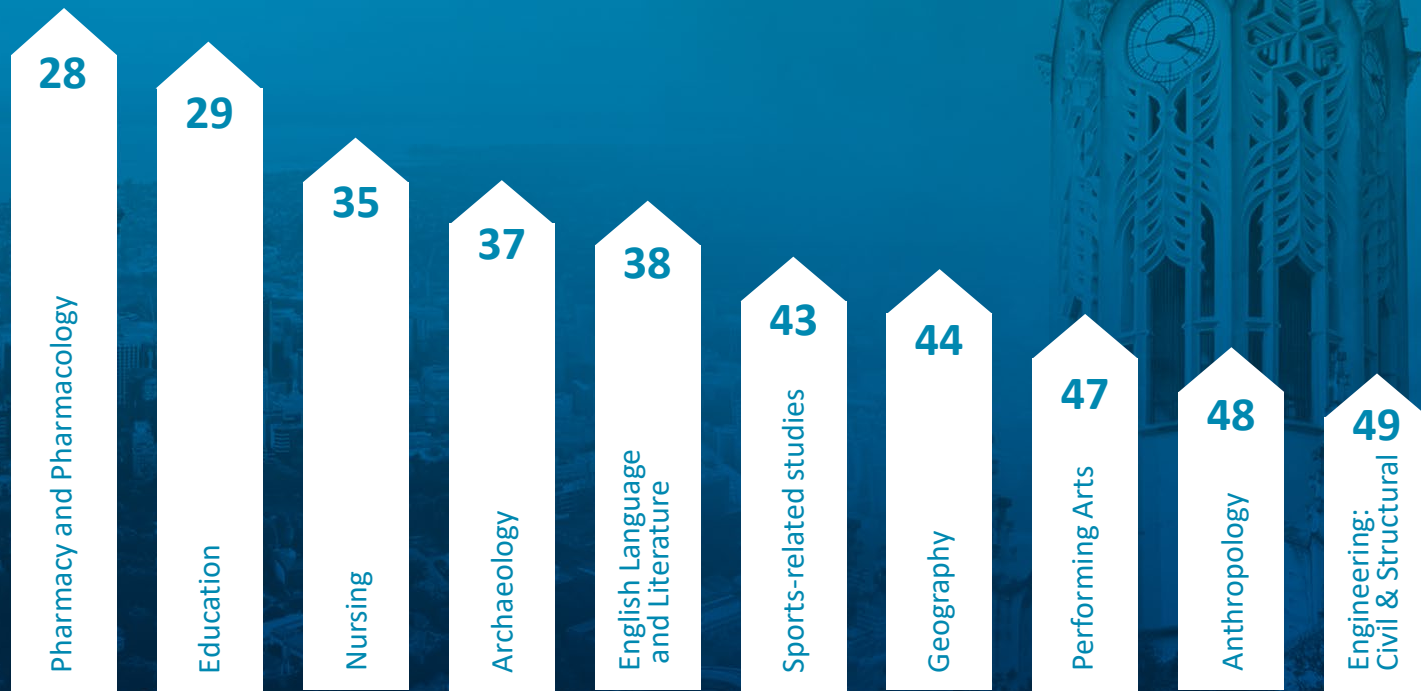

Study Abroad Programme

Spend one or two semester(s) and take credits back to your home university:

- Academic dates
 - Semester One – End Feb to Jun
 - Semester Two – Mid July to Nov
- Enrol in UG or PG courses across different subject areas (4 courses per semester)
- Check with your home university and get courses approved

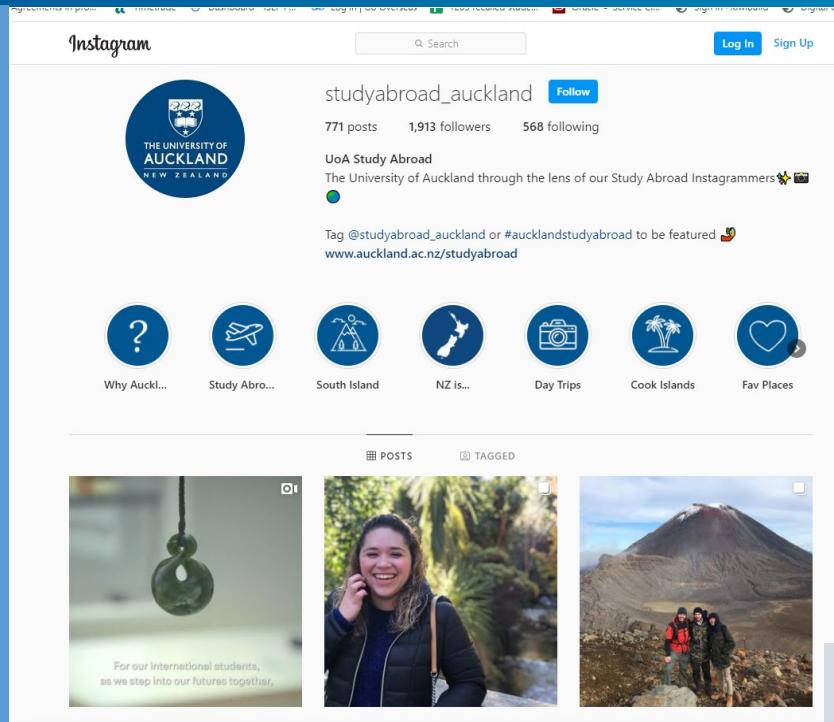

Reopening the New Zealand border

- **Step 1** – 27 February – NZ citizens and other eligible travellers coming from Australia
- **Step 2** – 04 March – NZ citizens and other eligible travellers coming from anywhere in the world. From 13 March, Working Holiday Visa processing starts on a rolling basis.
- **Step 3** – 12 April – Temporary work and student visa holders outside New Zealand and 5,000 international students.
- **Step 4** – from July – Australians, visitors from visa-waiver countries*.
- **Step 5** – from October – The border opens for all other New Zealand visa holders, including visitor and student visas, unless the visa is closed or paused.
