## TIERED TUITION FEES FOR STUDY ABROAD



To provide more options for our Study Abroad students, Victoria University has developed a tiered pricing scheme, available through our European partners. Rather than pay a standard per-trimester fee based on a maximum full-time workload, EU students have the option of reducing their costs if they are enrolled in fewer points.

Here is a table of fees for one trimester of study:

### SPECIAL EU STUDY ABROAD TUITION FEES FOR ONE TRIMESTER OF STUDY

### EXPLANATION OF FULL-TIME STUDY

At Victoria, the minimum full-time course load is 45 points for Trimester 1 or Trimester 2, however 60 points is considered the standard full-time work load. A student cannot take more than 120 points in any one year.

### EXPLANATION OF POINTS VALUES

Workload expectations for a course will vary according to the points value of the course. One point typically requires about 10 hours of student work, including both scheduled contact time (lectures, tutorials, laboratories, workshops, etc.) and individual (or group) study.
