



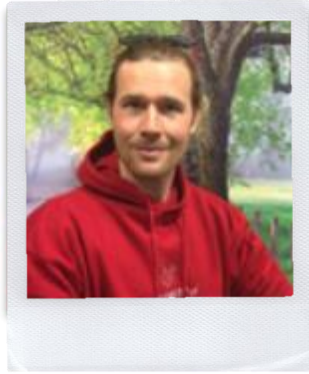

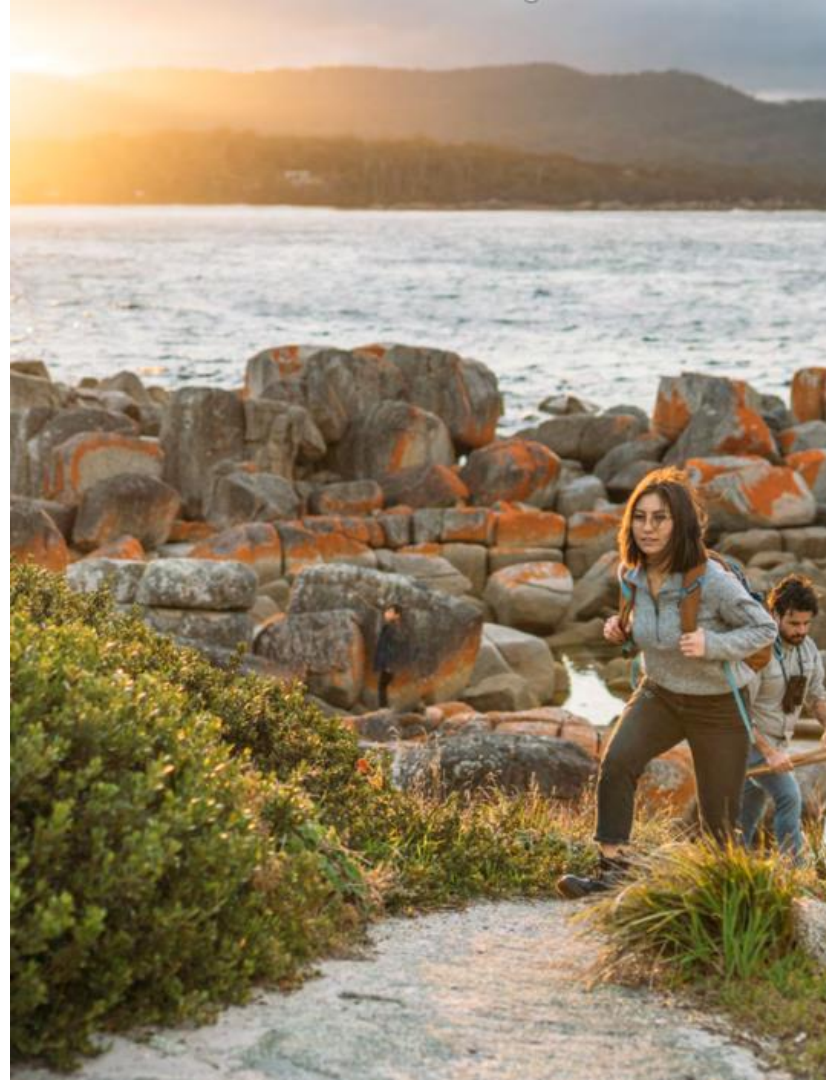

About 1/5 of the state is **UNESCO World Heritage** listed, 1.5 million hectares of wilderness

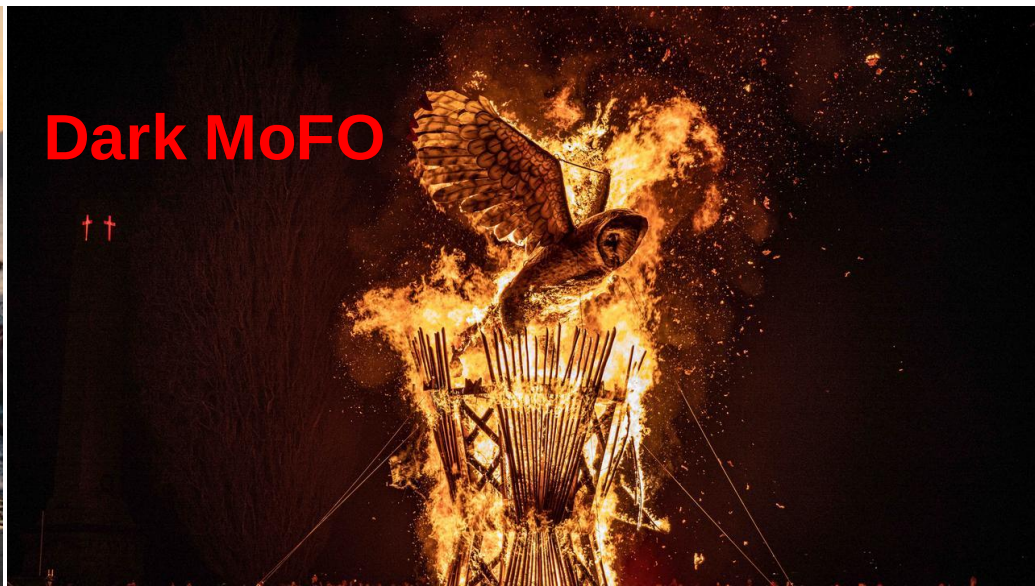


The Hobart campus is a **20-minute drive** from **Mt Wellington**

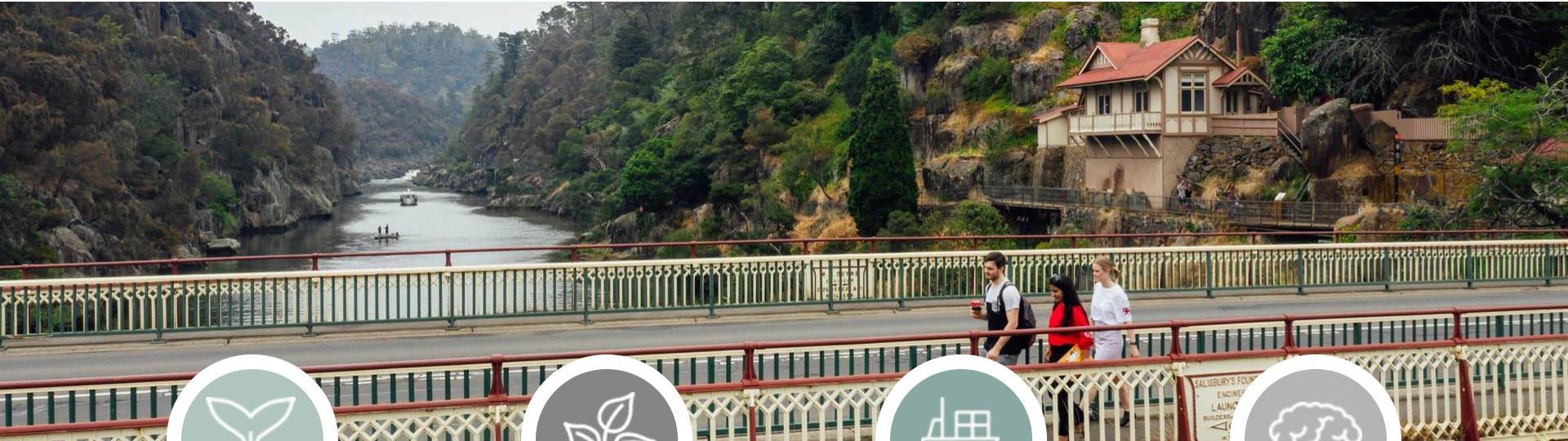
