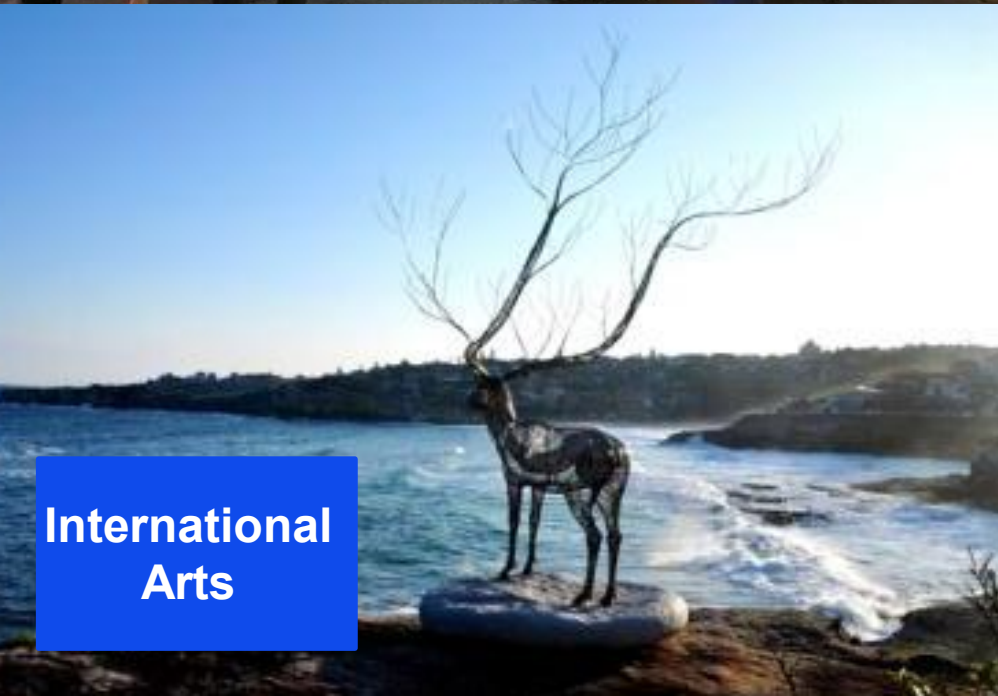

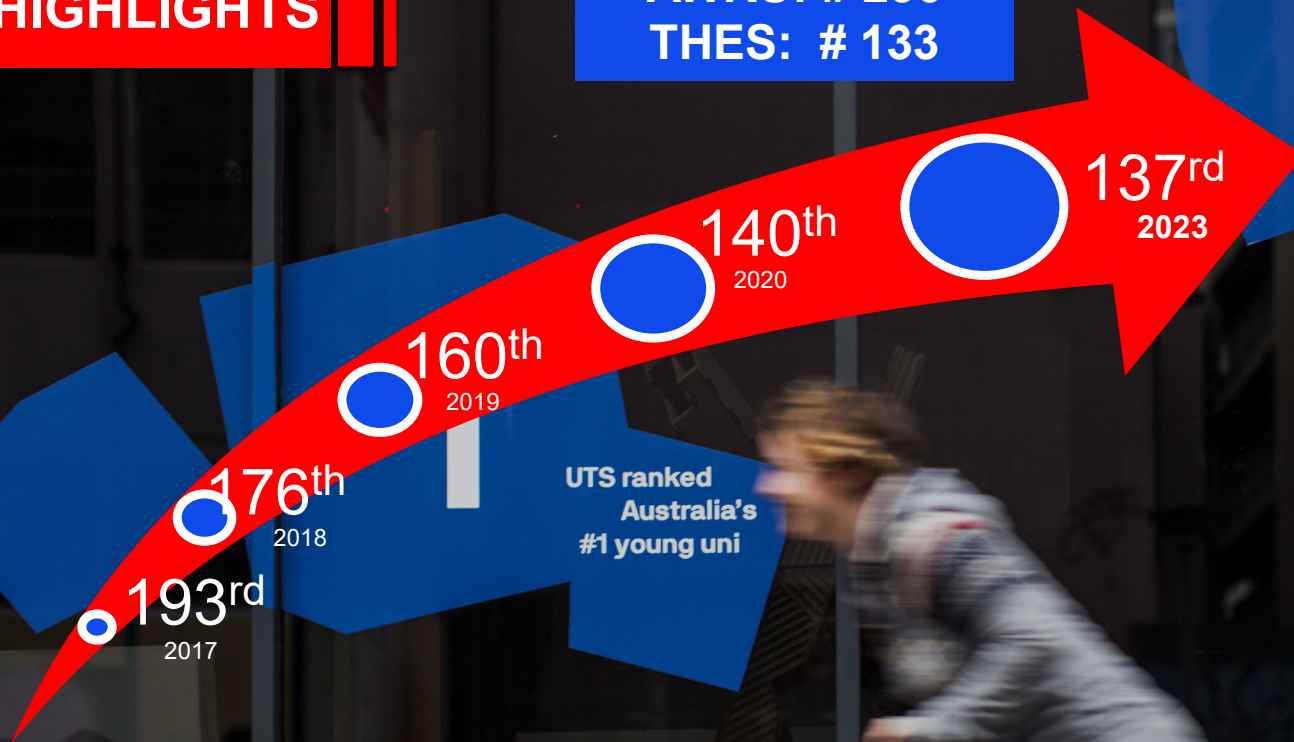

UTS takes pride in providing a warm welcome, arrival and integration for international students:

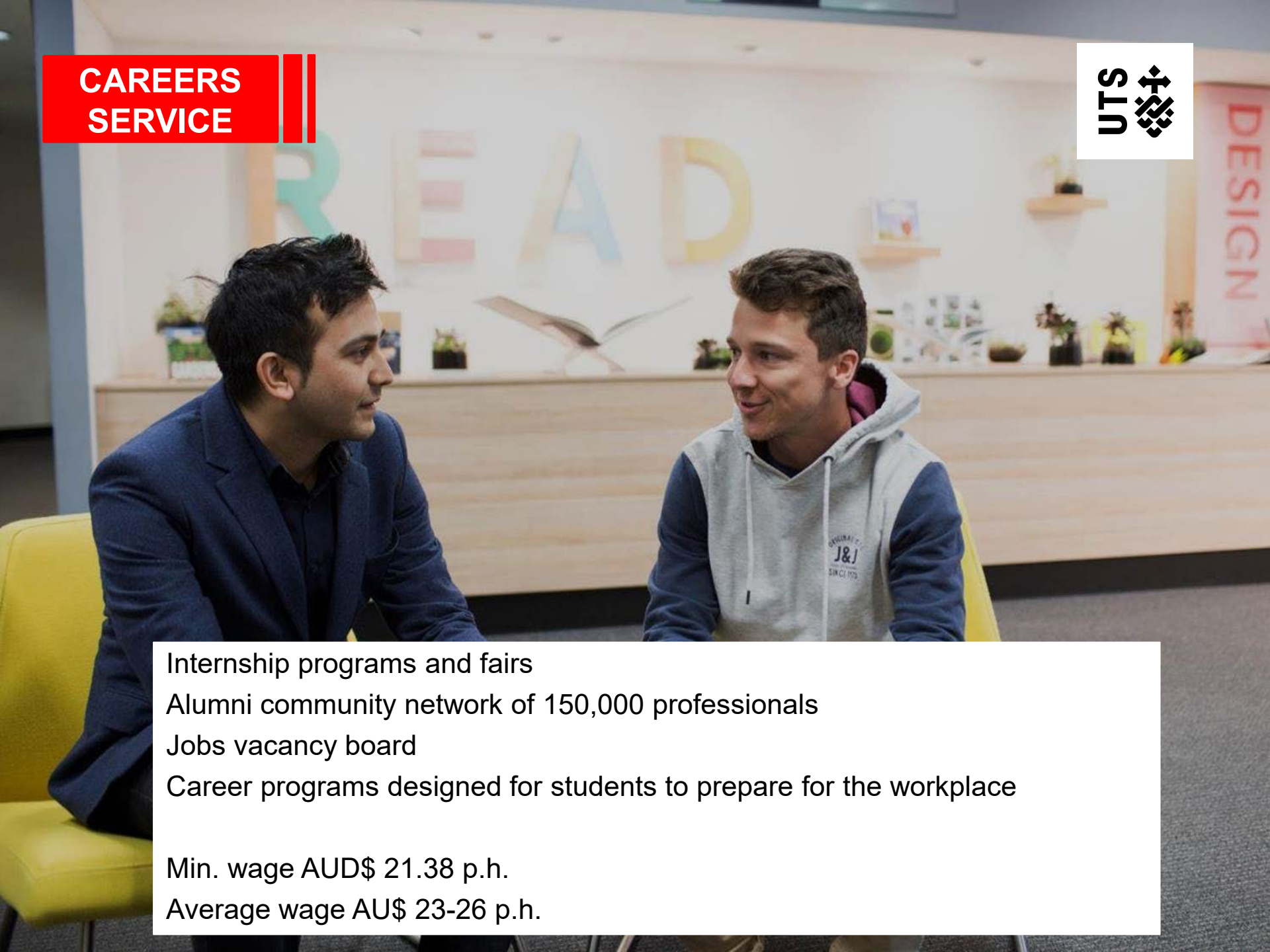
- Pre-departure communications including settling in to Sydney
