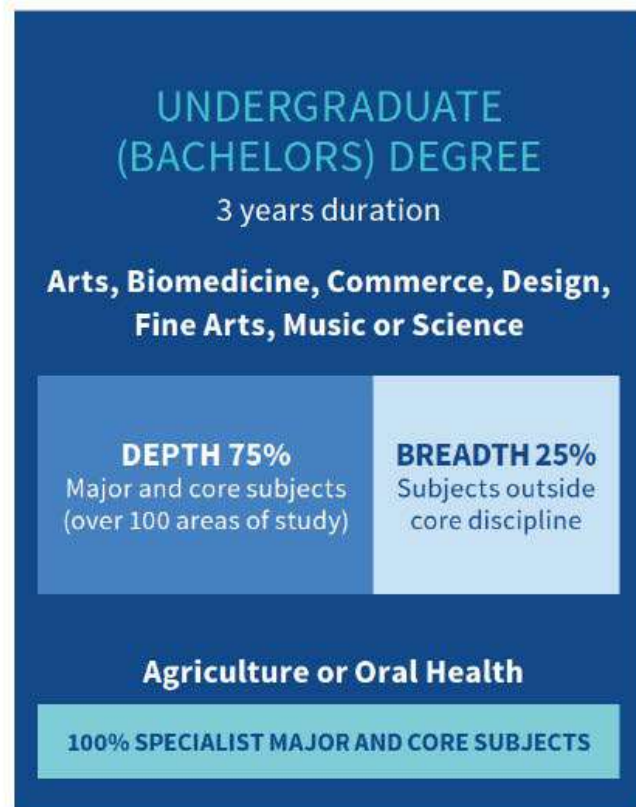

- ☐ 100% fee remission for duration of degree
- ☐ 50% fee remissions for duration of degree
- ☐ AUD\$10,000 fee remission-one-off payment
- ☐ Faculty scholarships (fee remission)
- ☐ Accommodation (reduction of living costs)

- ❖ Awarded for academic merit (final results)
- ❖ Automatically assessed (no separate application)
- ❖ Highly competitive
- ❖ Those unsuccessful for scholarship will not be notified

When should I apply?

International Students

- Apply through EDU
- Rolling admissions
- Application deadlines

Sem 1 (Feb/Mar)

1 December the year before

Sem 2 (Jul/Aug)

11 June the same year

Overseas Australians

- Apply through VTAC
- Application deadlines

Sem 1 (Feb/Mar)

Aug – Dec year before

Sem 2 (Jul/Aug)

Apr – Jun the same year
